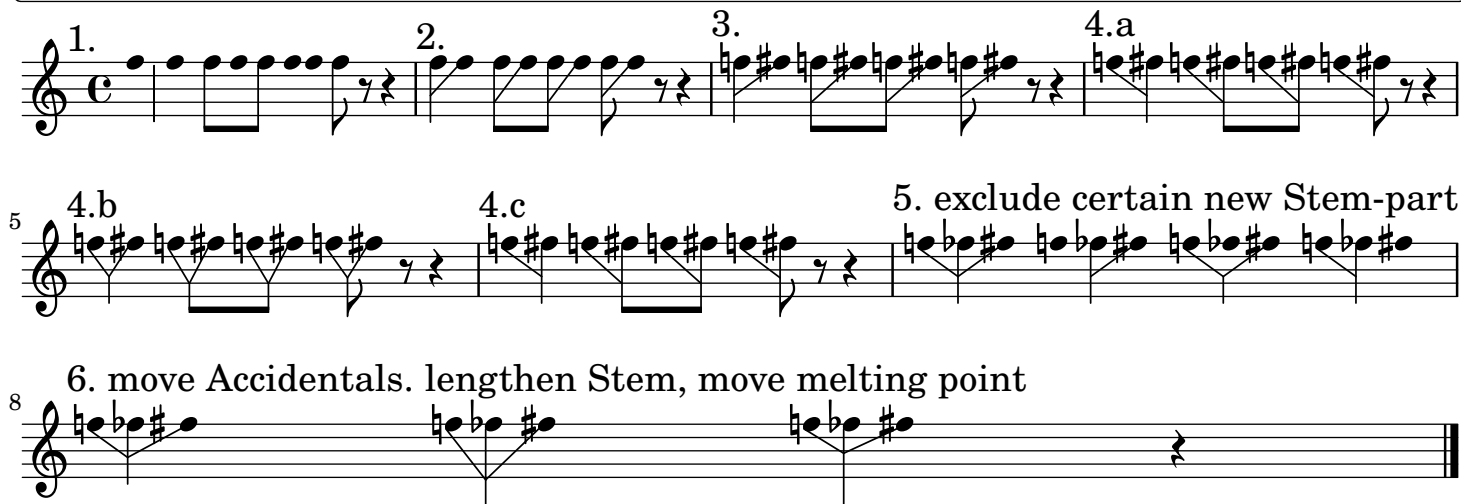
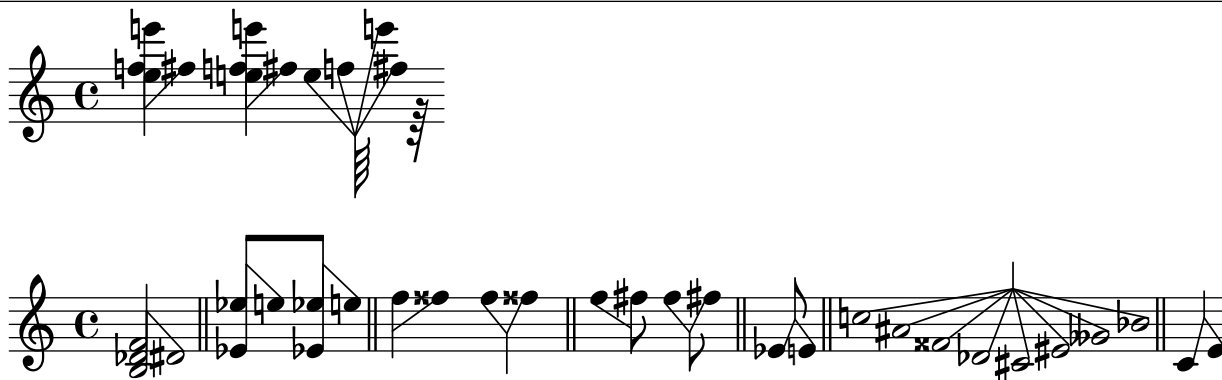


# USAGE

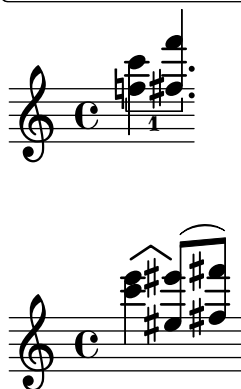
1. moved heads, no Stem-tweaking
2. split Stem, main Stem left
3. accidentals follow
4. main Stem at other positions
5. exclude certain new Stem-part
6. move Accidentals, lengthen Stem, move melting point
